President Hendricks called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He discussed the fall leaf collection. Also, two roll-offs will be available to residents twice: October 16-19 and November 13-16. It is yet to be determined if the RSD would prefer bagged or loose leaves placed in the roll-offs.

Mr. Lukacek called fence heights to the attention of the board, particularly around pools.

A.J. Sickmann is working with the Sheriff and his counsel regarding the hiring of off-duty officers to aid in speed control on Waterfall Road.

Mr. Werner moved, seconded by Mr. Clark acceptance of the minutes of August 11, unanimous.
